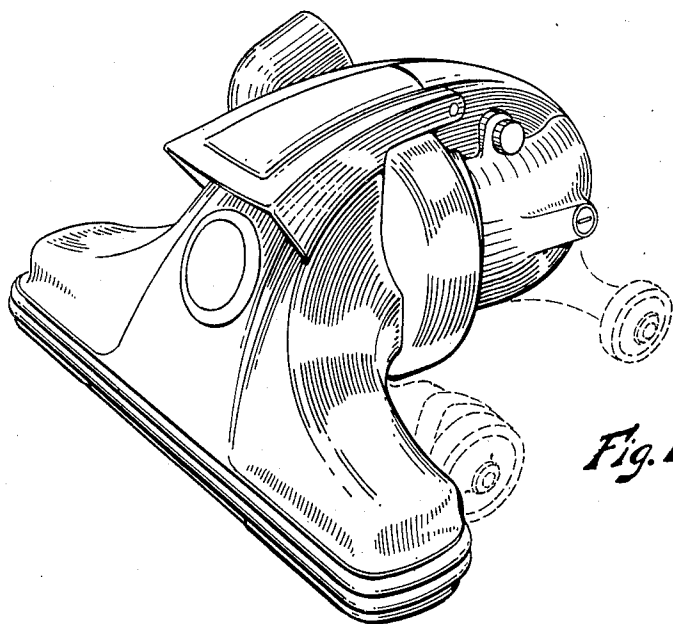

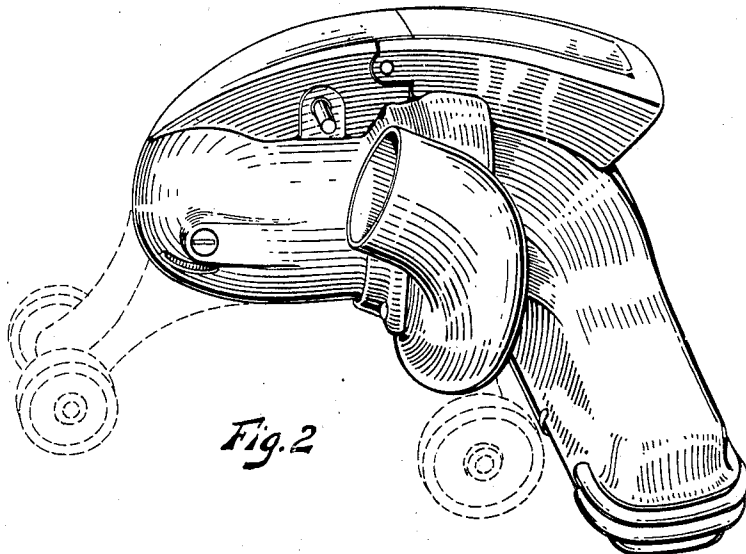

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, James B. Kirby, a citizen of the United States, residing at West Richfield, in the county of Summit and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Suction Cleaner Casing, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing—

Figure 1 is a front perspective view of a suction cleaner casing; and Figure 2 is a rear perspective view of the same, showing my new design.
