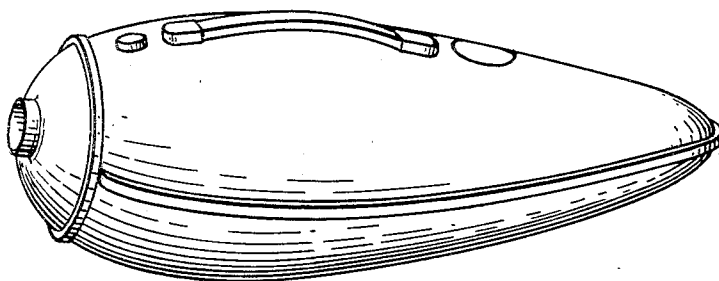

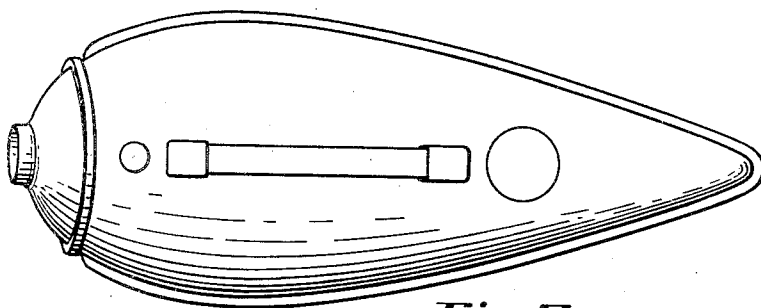

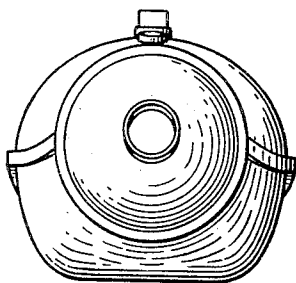

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, James B. Kirby, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at West Richfield, in the county of Summit and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dust Collector and Blower Housing for Vacuum Cleaners, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a dust collector and blower housing for vacuum cleaners embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view of the dust collector and blower housing for vacuum cleaners shown in Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 is an end elevation of the dust collector and blower housing for vacuum cleaners shown in Fig. 1.
