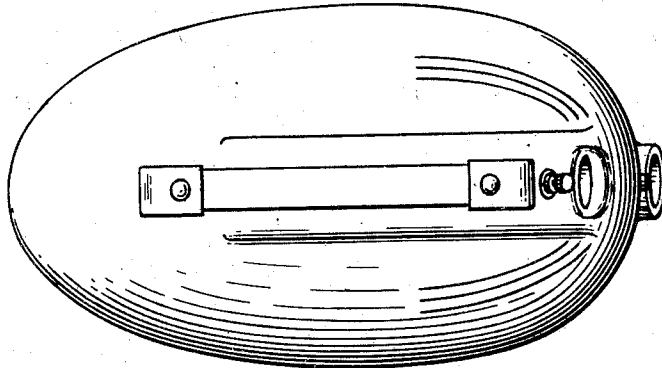

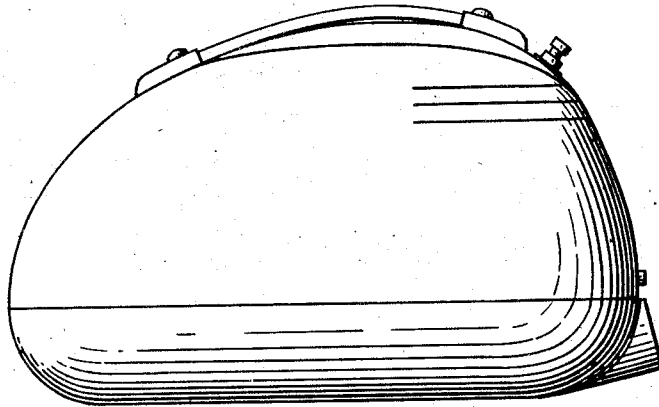

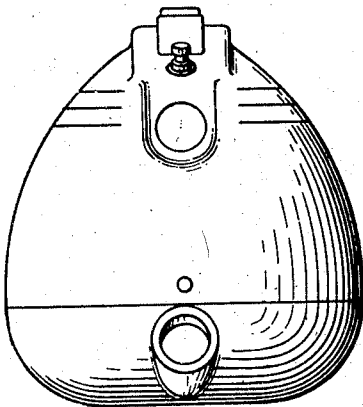

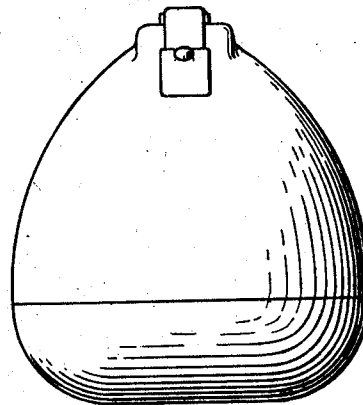

DESIGN FOR A VACUUM CLEANER TANK

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, James B. Kirby, a citizen of the United States, residing at West Richfield, in the county of Summit and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vacuum Cleaner Tank, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a plan view of the vacuum cleaner tank showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the vacuum cleaner tank;

Fig. 3 is an elevation of the front end of the vacuum cleaner tank; and

Fig. 4 is an elevation of the rear end of the vacuum cleaner tank.
