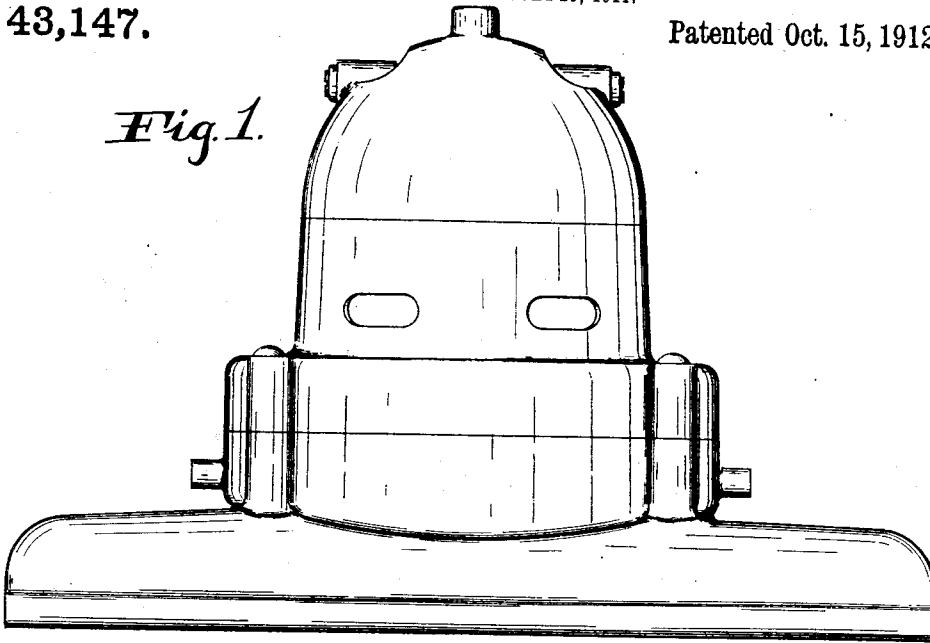
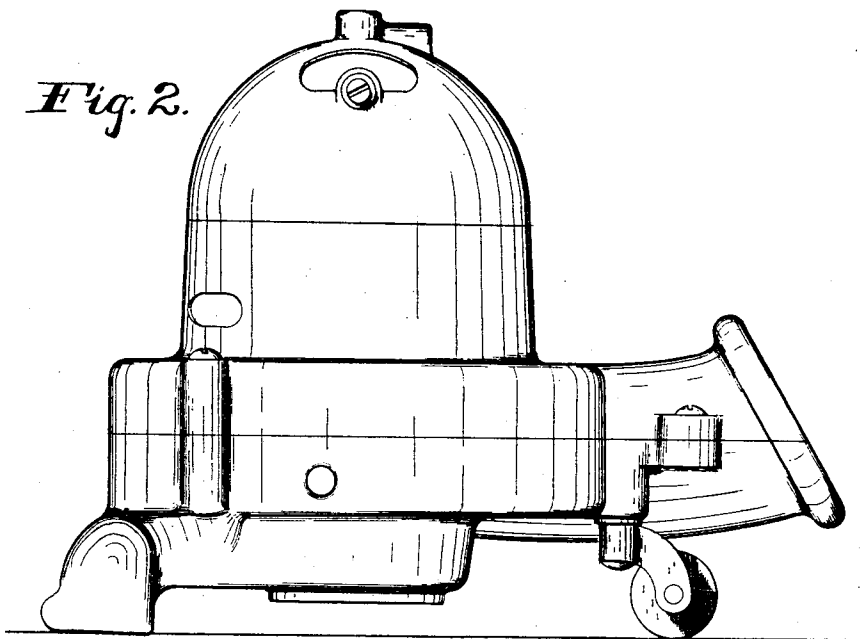

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES B. KIRBY, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Casings for Pneumatic Cleaners, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a casing for a pneumatic cleaner showing my new
