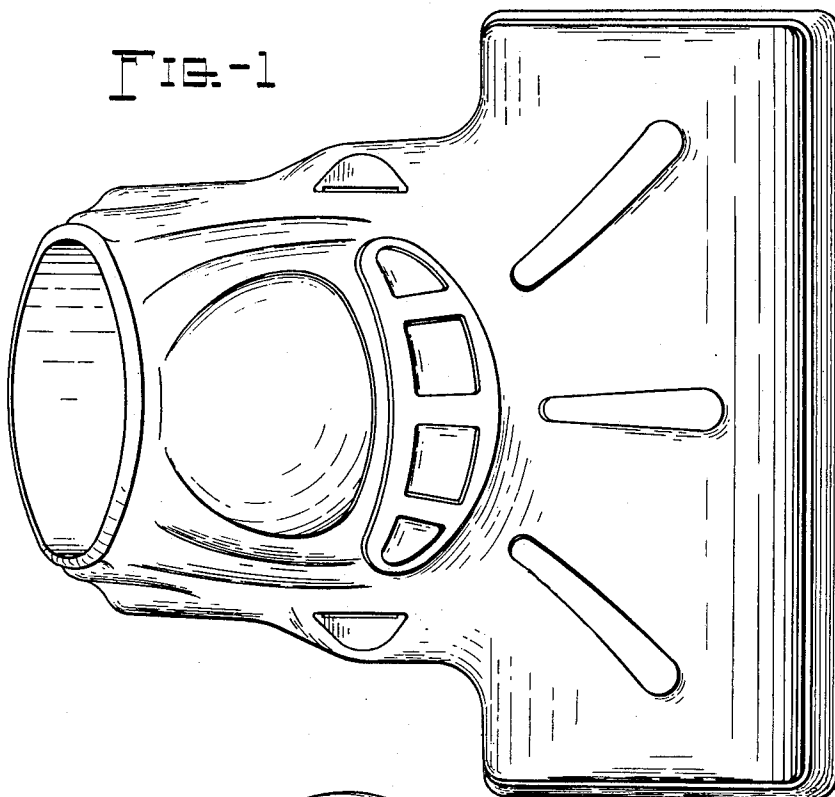
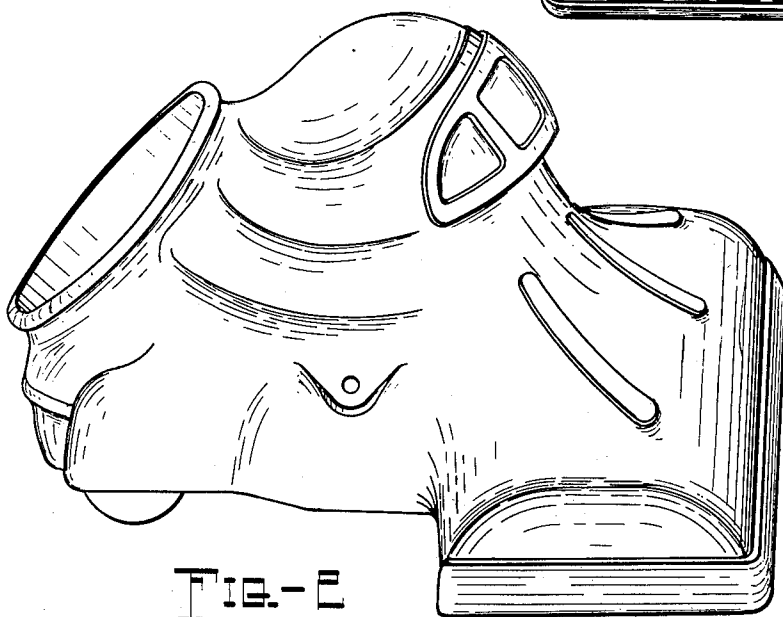

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES B. KIRBY, a citizen of the United States of America, and a resident of West Richfield, in the county of Summit and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Suction Cleaner Casing, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing, Figure 1 is a plan view, and Figure 2 is a perspective view of a suction cleaner casing embodying my new design.
